SAINT CHRISTOPHER AND NEVIS

AN ACT to amend the Anti-Terrorism Act, Cap. 4.02

[Published 1st December 2011, Official Gazette No. 62 of 2011.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the National Assembly of Saint Christopher and Nevis, and by the authority of the same as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the Anti-Terrorism (Amendment) Act, 2011.

2. INTERPRETATION.

In this Act the term "Act" means the Anti-Terrorism Act, Cap. 4.02.

3. AMENDMENT OF SECTION 78.

The Act is amended in section 78 subsection (5) as follows:

(a) in paragraph (a) by replacing the expression "seven thousand" with the expression "seventy five thousand dollars"; in paragraph (b) by replacing the expression "thirty" with the expression "one hundred thousand".

4. AMENDMENT OF ACT.

The Act is amended by inserting immediately after section 78, a new section 78A as follows:

“ 78A. TIPPING OFF.

Where a person knows or suspects that

- (a) an investigation into terrorist financing, any other offence specified in this Act or other related investigation; or
- (b) that a suspicious transaction report

has been, is being or is about to be made, and divulges that fact or other related information to another person, whereby the disclosure of the fact or other related information is likely to prejudice the investigation, commits an offence, and shall be liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding one hundred thousand

dollars or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three years or to both such fine and imprisonment.

4. By inserting a new clause 5 as follows:

“ **5. AMENDMENT OF SECTION 90A.**

The Act is amended in section 90A by inserting immediately after the expression “Taliban”, the expression, “Al Qaida or any other terrorist group”.
