AN ORDINANCE to amend the Nevis Business Corporation Ordinance, No. 1 of 2017 and for matters related thereto and connected therewith.

[Published 10th November 2022, Official Gazette No. 67 of 2022.]

BE IT ENACTED by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Nevis Island Assembly and by the authority of same, as follows:-

1. Short Title

This Ordinance may be cited as the Nevis Business Corporation (Amendment) Ordinance, 2022.

2. Interpretation

In this Ordinance, the "Principal Ordinance" means the Nevis Business Corporation Ordinance, No. 1 of 2017.

3. Amendment to Section 119

Section 119 of the Principal Ordinance is amended as follows:

- (a) In the heading by deleting the heading in its entirety and replacing it as follows:

"119. Removal from the register and restoration."

- (b) In subsection (4) by deleting the subsection in its entirety and replacing it as follows:

"(4) A corporation which is removed from the register pursuant to subsections (1) and (2) shall, subject to subsection (7), be restored to the register within three (3) years of the date of removal upon filing an application for restoration with the Registrar of Corporations in the prescribed form together with the prescribed fee for restoration and all outstanding fees and penalties accrued as at the date of the application."
